Imagine Your Story Summer Library Program 2020

It's officially here! Welcome to Summer Library Program 2020: Imagine Your Story!

Things will be a little (OK, a lot!) different this year due to the current public health crisis. SLP is going virtual this summer. Thanks to support from the Mississippi Library Commission, WCVPL will use a new online tool for our virtual program, Beanstack.

On Beanstack, you can register for SLP, log your time spent reading, attend virtual programs, complete special challenges and enter to win prizes! You will earn badges as you complete each task and meet reading goals. Beanstack even has an app for iOS and Android devices!

Here is how the Virtual SLP will work:

- 1. Registration opens July 1st
- 2. Find and click on the link to Beanstack on our Facebook page.
- 3. Register as a new reader. Families and groups (such as daycare centers) may register together or older children may register independently.
- 4. Enter the Imagine Your Story Summer Library Program 2020 Challenge.
- 5. Stop by the library to pick up your registration packet. You will need to call from the parking lot to let the staff know you're here. We answer the phone from 9:00 am to 4:45 pm.
- 6. Begin logging your reading time!
- 7. Watch all five virtual programs: Dorian LaChance's two programs: Once Upon a Wonder Filled Time and The Virtual Magic Academy, Harry Potter Potion Class with Professor Shackelbolt, Three Little Pigs: House of Straw, House of Sticks, House of Bricks and Build Rapunzel's Tower:

 Engineering You Can Eat! If you want to follow along with the activity, you will need some items on hand. The materials list is included with the registration packet.
- 8. Find and read a "rebooted" (retelling or fractured) version of a classic fairy tale. There are four of these. Don't forget to include them in your reading time logs.
- 9. Six craft activities. Parts for these crafts, glue sticks and 8-count boxes of crayons are included with the registration packet.
- 10. Write 3 book reviews.
- 11. Registration for SLP guarantees you one entry in the prize drawing. Follow the instructions and complete the tasks for more chances to enter your name.

12. The program ends July 29th. We will hold the prize drawings once we have ensured everyone has their earned number of entries. Staff will contact the winners.

Even though we are not fully open to the public, you can still get books from the library with curbside service. You can only get five books at a time per library card but you can request more the next day. Don't forget about our digital services, including eBooks and eAudio; these count, too!

Pick-up Service

- Hours: Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:45 pm
- Call, 601-636-6411, or email, curbsidepickup@warren.lib.ms.us
- Limit 5 items per library card
- Provide name, library card number, working cell phone number and names of 5 items (specify book, large type, audiobook, DVD, children's, teen, graphic novel) Family members may call in requests on same order; please provide individual card number for each
- The staff will assign a pick up time (staff will need at least two hours) - arrive at appointed time & call from parking lot
- Staff will bring your items and take your returned items to check in
- Any fines and fees charged to library accounts prior to closure (March 16th) must be paid in full to receive curbside pick up service.
- If you cannot arrive at appointed time, please call and notify staff
- Requests received after 4:00 pm will not be ready for pick up until the next day beginning at 10:00 am

We are constantly tweaking our curbside service to improve it, so we respectfully ask for our patrons' patience and understanding.

Drop Off Service

- Hours: Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:45 pm
- The book drop will remain closed for quarantine procedures
- Book bin and AV cart will be outside the lobby door
- · Patrons may place items on designated carts
- Returned items must sit in quarantine for 5 days after check in; they will not be available to the patrons during this time
