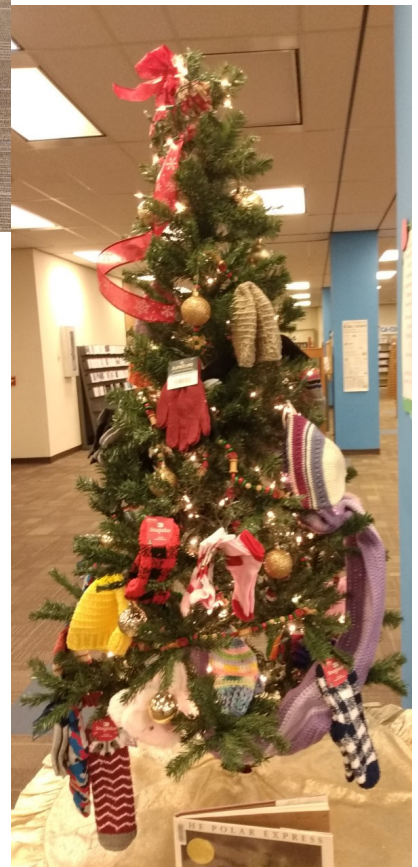


# Thank You For 2021's Warming Tree!

# Mask Requirements Will Remain in Place for January



Any patron/guest wanting to make use of the library must wear a mask that fully covers their nose and mouth. The mask must be worn by all patrons age 2 and above while inside the library, including the lobby area.

We request that anyone who has been recently exposed to someone who has tested positive for any of the COVID variants or who is running a fever (or displaying any other signs of illness regardless of the cause) please refrain from using the public areas of the library until they are past their quarantine period or feeling well again to protect their fellow patrons and the children who make use of our facilities.

We ask that patrons continue to respect their fellow patrons if they prefer to continue to social distance from others. Please keep in mind that vaccinations are still not an option for our youngest patrons under the age of 5.

## As a reminder:

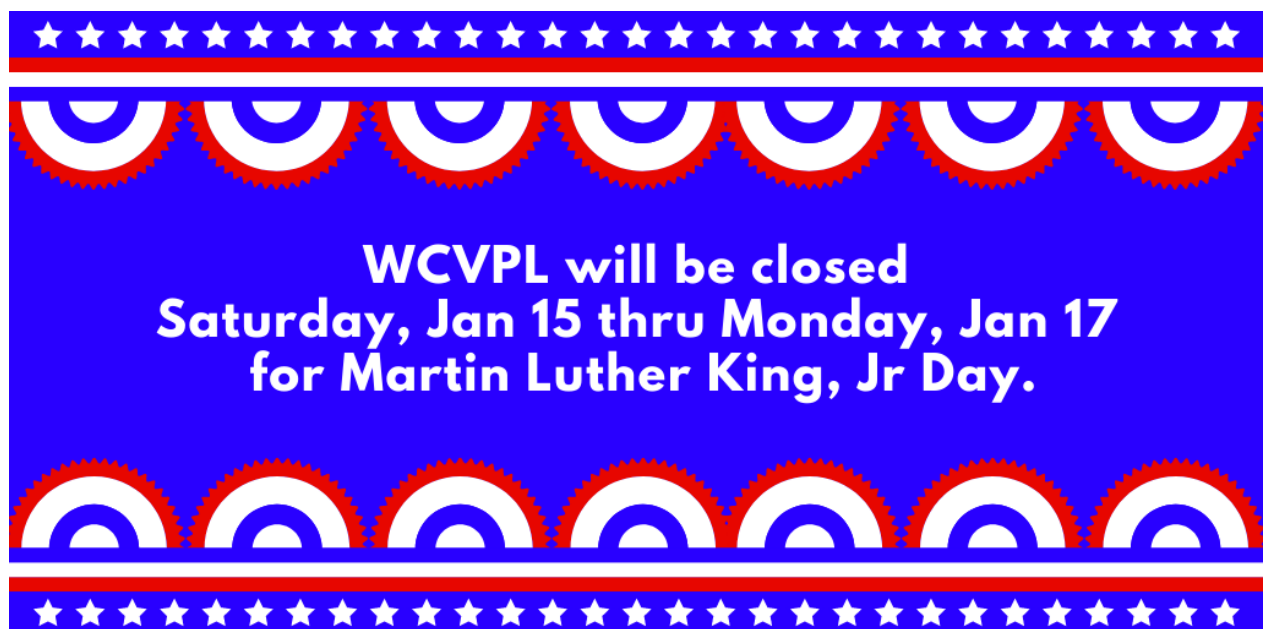
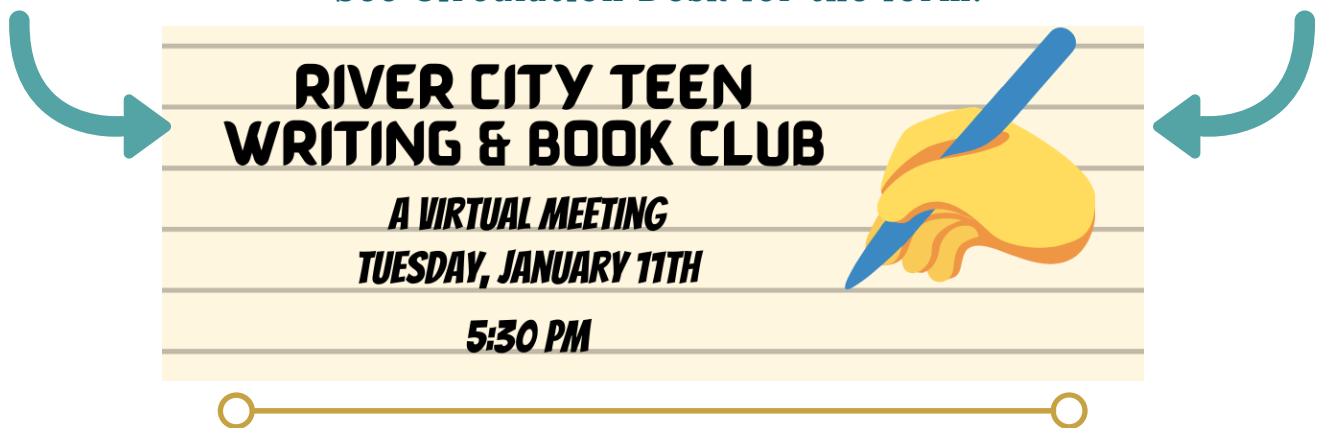
Seating/study areas inside the library are NOT currently available - this includes sitting on the stools or on the floor. Our Meeting Room is currently unavailable for any public functions.
