## **Phase Three Begins June 1 : What That Means**

1) A mask that fully covers the nose and mouth must be worn by all patrons age 2 and above while inside the library, including the lobby. While we will not be restricting access by numbers after June 1, we ask that patrons continue to respect their fellow patrons if they prefer to continue to social distance from others.

2) Appointments will no longer be necessary to browse our collection or to make use of our computers. Computer usage will return to our usual one-hour period with patrons able to extend their time in 15 minute increments so long as no other patrons are waiting to use the computers (maximum 3 hours usage a day for eligible patrons). Guests will be allowed their first hour of computer use for free with the ability to extend for additional time (up to 1 hour is a \$1 charge) - again, so long as no one else is holding for a computer with a maximum of 3 hours total.

3) We request that anyone who has been recently exposed to someone who is positive for COVID-19 or who is running a fever (or displaying any other signs of illness regardless of the cause) please refrain from using the public areas of the library until they are feeling well again to protect their fellow patrons and the children who make use of our facilities.

4) Parents are no longer limited to bringing in only one child. As mentioned before, all children age 2 and above must wear a mask while inside the library.

5) Our outside drop box has been reopened and all non-ILL books may be returned there. A/V materials and ILL books will still need to be returned inside during our normal working hours.

6) We will be returning to Saturday hours on June 5 - 9 am to 5 pm with curbside service 10 am to 4:45 pm.

7) Restrooms and seating/study areas inside the library are NOT currently available.

8) For patrons who have mobility issues or that currently wish to continue to avoid excessive public contact, we are continuing to provide curbside service. As is currently the policy, we ask for pickup times to be scheduled to allow for items to be delivered in a timely fashion.

## Curbside Pick-up Continues

Our curbside service for our patrons who don't care to come back inside yet will continue for the month of June. For details on how to make use of our curbside services, see below:

### Curbside Service

- Hours: Mon to Thu, 10 am to 6:45 pm/Fri & Sat 10 am to 4:45 pm

- Limit 5 items per library card. Provide name, library card number, working cell phone number and names of 5 items (specify book, large type, audiobook, DVD, children's, teen, graphic novel) Family members may call in requests on same order; please provide individual card number for each.
- The staff will assign a pick up time (staff will need at least **two hours**) - arrive at appointed time & call from parking lot. Staff will bring your items and take your returned items to check in
- If you cannot arrive at appointed time, please call and notify staff
- Requests received after 4:00 pm will not be ready for pick up until the next working day beginning at 10:00 am

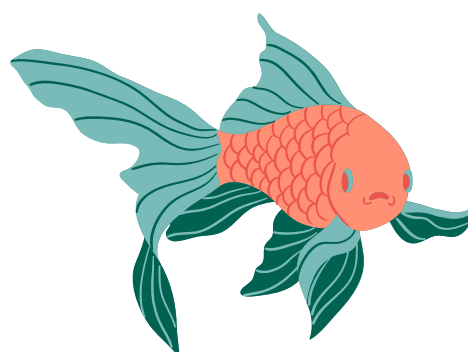
